

Official List of A. L. A. Garages and Attorneys

Carry the latest list of garages and attorneys and your membership card in your car at all times. The official list appears each month in *The Automoblist*. Use the new list as it appears.

THE following is a list of the officially appointed A. L. A. garages to render free emergency garage service to its members when in difficulty while on the road.

This work is very comprehensive, and, generally speaking, includes temporary repairs to broken springs, broken steering gear, clutch trouble, brake trouble, which prevents one from operating his car safely, broken wheel, ignition and battery trouble, bringing gas and oil, changing tires, and such other trouble as would prevent one from his operating his automobile under its own power, and if the repairs cannot reasonably be made on the road, the garage will tow the member to its garage, but the member must in all cases call the nearest appointed garage to where they are and not the nearest appointed garages to their homes.

Garages indicated thus (+) authorize us to announce that they will give our members a discount of one cent a gallon on gasoline if our members will produce their membership cards and books of coupons.

No garage is authorized to travel more than ten miles from its place of business at our expense. Members must themselves pay the travelling fee and towing in excess of ten miles from the garage and return to within ten miles of the garage.

This service does not include unnecessary repairs or the hauling of a car out of an embankment or any other place where the four wheels are off the road, nor the unloading and reloading of a truck if such is neces-

sary, nor does it include work done on a member's car in any garage whether public or private, except the changing of flat tires, in our official garages.

Upon receiving this issue of *The Automoblist*, members are requested to disregard the old garage directories and lists published in previous issues of our magazine. The list below is the latest published by the Association, and contains all additions, changes and cancellations among our official garages, and also a complete list of our attorneys. If you use an old list or directory and don't get service you have only yourself to blame. The list of official garages will be printed in each issue of *The Automoblist*.

Police Activities

THERE is an active campaign being conducted by members of the State Constabulary on many of the main highways against driving so as to endanger the lives and safety of the public, such as passing another car on a hill or where the view is obstructed or at a curve in the road. There have been a great many serious accidents this year due to these violations and the State Constabulary has been instructed to enforce the law rigidly.

The officers are particularly active in Andover, Salem, Stoughton and Concord and on the South Shore highways. Conviction for this offence will mean the revocation of your license.

MASSACHUSETTS

ARLINGTON—Motorcycle officer unusually active in this town. Prosecuting for speeding, passing to the left of trolley cars and not sounding the horn at intersecting ways.

BOSTON—In view of the stringent enforcement of the parking regulations in this city car owners should consult a traffic officer before parking their cars on any of the downtown streets if they are in doubt of the parking limit.

Motorcycle officers are very active on Jamaica way and the Arborway and constantly patrol this section of the park system. Do not exceed a speed limit of 20 miles per hour.

Boston police have started a campaign against operators of cars that have only one headlight illuminated, also for not having the rear lamp lighted. Fines are being imposed in each case where there is a conviction. Examine your headlamp and rear lamp bulbs and you will save yourself a lot of trouble. Inspectors connected with the office of the Registrar of Motor Vehicles are also conducting a State-wide campaign on lights.

Two uniformed officers are operating a speed trap on Centre Street, Dorchester District. One officer is stationed at Melbourne and Centre Streets and the other just above Seaborn Street and is stopping cars speeding up the hill towards Codman Square.

CAMBRIDGE—Police officers are active on the main thoroughfares against trucks for violation of the mirror law.

HARWICHPORT—It is reported that the Constable of this town is rigidly enforcing the speed laws. He drives a new Oldsmobile sport model, painted green, with Massachusetts registration 389639, and, we are advised, usually has passengers riding with him so as to take off the official appearance of the car. He is reported to drive at a fast rate of speed and if passed by a motorist immediately stops the offending car which means a trip to court. Do not drive faster than 20 miles an hour in this town.

LEXINGTON—Two officers using a Ford car are conducting an active campaign at night against motorists who park their cars at the side of the road or on private property without lights.

MALDEN—Campaign against motorists driving to the left or within eight feet of a street car that has stopped to discharge passengers. Fine of \$25 being imposed upon conviction.

NAHANT—Campaign being conducted by the local police against cars parked without being properly lighted.

REVERE BEACH BOULEVARD—Speeding along this thoroughfare will cost you a fine of \$20. The speed limit is 20 miles per hour, do not exceed it.

SOMERVILLE—On Franklin Street, between Washington and Pearl Streets, local police are operating a trap for speeding up the hill and not sounding the horn at intersecting streets.

SPRINGFIELD—Officer active on State Street, entering city en route from Boston, for speeding. Fine of \$20 being imposed for each conviction.

NEW HAMPSHIRE

MANCHESTER—Police of this city issued another warning that arrests will follow further violation of the 30 minutes' parking rule on Elm Street and other main thoroughfares where traffic is heavy during the day time. Cars, in the past, have been tagged and the owners upon reporting to Police Headquarters have been lectured. The patience of the police officers has been severely tried and failure to respect this new time limit rule will mean a summons to court.

What the A.L.A. Does and Does Not Do for Its Members

Legal Defense in Criminal Cases

THE Association furnishes the services of its attorneys to defend its members, their chauffeurs, or anyone who may be operating their automobile with the owner's permission, when charged with any violation of the automobile laws, traffic rules of cities and towns, and the rules and regulations of park commissioners.

The Association, however, does not furnish the services of its attorneys to defend its members when charged with operating an automobile while under the influence of intoxicating liquors or when charged with manslaughter or murder.

Legal Defense in Civil Suits

THE Association furnishes the services of its attorneys to defend its members when suits are brought against them for damage to the property of another.

The Association does not furnish the services of its attorneys to bring suits for its members in any case whatever, nor does it act as a collecting agency to collect bills; for the Association is organized to furnish defense to its members and not to promote litigation or to bring suits or to annoy or harass automobilists in any way.

Legal Advice

WHILE the Association will not defend its members when charged with manslaughter, murder or the operation of automobiles while under the influence of intoxicating liquors, and will not bring suits to collect bills for its members who may have a claim against another automobilist, it will gladly furnish the services of its attorneys to advise these members in all matters or in any other matter in which a member may be concerned as the owner or operator of an automobile.

Touring Information

EACH member is entitled to all the service we can possibly furnish him relating to touring information, road conditions, assistance in making up his trips, advice relating to hotels and garages; and upon the renewal of his

membership is entitled to the current issue of the Green book, or our book of maps if preferred.
